

**SUBCONTRACTOR CERTIFICATION FOR COMPLIANCE WITH FAR 52.204-10,
EXECUTIVE COMPENSATION AND FIRST-TIER SUBCONTRACT REPORTING**

If an award over \$25,000 is made as a result of your proposal, the subsequent subcontract may include FAR 52.204-10, Executive Compensation and First-Tier Subcontractor Reporting, and the Offeror shall be required after contract award, to release to Arété the information related to the organization with whom we are contracting (not a parent organization) necessary for us to fulfill our reporting obligations, unless Offeror meets the exemption requirements stated in the clause (less than 80% of revenue from government sources, and less than \$25 million in government revenue, and the public does not already have access to compensation information via the SEC or IRS, normally only true for publicly traded companies).

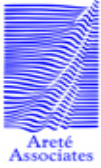
